Initial funding pre-commitment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Industry, Innovation, Trade and Tourism Department of the Basque Government launches the GAITEK programme, which supports projects for the development of new products. The average budget every year is 22M€.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The calls are horizontal, which means that topics are not restricted in any technological field. The projects presented should be aligned with the Science, Technology and Innovation Plan 2010 (PCTI 2010 <a href="http://www.industria.ejgv.euskadi.net/r44-886/es/contenidos/informacion/pcti2010/es_pcti2010/pcti2010.html">http://www.industria.ejgv.euskadi.net/r44-886/es/contenidos/informacion/pcti2010/es_pcti2010/pcti2010.html</a>). In this Plan, Biosciences and Nanosciences are recognized as emerging sectors in the Basque Country.</li> <li>The initial commitment of the Basque Government for the Euronanomed second call do not limit a top budget to fund projects, as both of the programmes do not allocate specific budgets for specific topics. So, in principle, there is no budget restriction of Basque funding programmes for projects in the Euronanomed first call.</li> </ul>

<b>Funding delivery by ISCIII, requirements</b>	<p>Every year, funds are allocated as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 70% of pre-financing after the official awarding of the project.</li> <li>• 30% after report of scientific progress and justification of expenses allocated for that year in the project.</li> </ul>
<b>Grant awarded by the Basque Government, decision and requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The “EuroNanoMed” transnational projects with partners from the Basque Country which will be recommended by the CSC, will be tentatively awarded by the Basque Government from January 2010 on.</li> </ul>
