Eligibility of Institutions	<p>The applicants must contact the National Contact Point and submit a draft description of the project to the Technological Development Fund (TDF) before May 11th, 2010.</p> <p>TDF will respond within 2 weeks if the project is considered to satisfy the evaluation criteria of TDF. The fund does not have formal limitations on projects that can be supported but the evaluation criteria for the Technology Development Fund (TDF) are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clearly defined idea about economic value and likely gain of the project. • Research and development of new or improved products and processes. • Production of technological prototypes to test and develop technological qualities. • Production of a prototype to test the market. • Business plans and market studies. <p>A full application must be submitted to the Technology Development Fund at same time as the application is submitted to the EuroNanoMed (This will be used by the Fund for the eligibility evaluation)</p>
Eligibility of Researchers	- Same as for institutions (see above)
Eligibility of project duration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Up to 3 years.
Cap funding per grant awarded to an eligible Icelandic institution as beneficiary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum funding per year is 10 million ISK, for up to 3 years.

Eligibility of cost and their caps	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Grants maximum half of the total cost.
Icelandic funding delivery	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Every half year 40% pre-financing and 20% post financing after a yearly report of scientific progress and justification of expenses charged to previous grant pre-financing, checks and assessments.
