Eligibility of a partner as a beneficiary institution	All recognized research institutes in Israel (Universities, research Institutes, Hospitals, Research Colleges) Industry or SME – only as "non-funded partner"
Eligibility of a core research team member:	Israeli researchers may apply only to one project. An Israeli researcher (PI or CoI) who is funded by CSO-MOH cannot apply. Israeli researchers in a EuroNanoMed consortium are regarded as "Primary Investigator" (PI).
Ineligibility of a core research team members:	Excluded Israeli researcher may apply only as a non-funded partner
Eligibility of costs, types and their caps	Person power (Salaries for PI and CoI are not eligible), animals (purchase and maintenance), consumables, publications and office supplies, travel (up to 6,000€, only related to the funded project), Institutional overhead (up to 10%)

Grant awarded by the Party, decision and requirements	Formal forms after funding decisions. Bio-ethics approvals by local IRB
